### WP2 - Online Employability Modules

Interactive games, educational material and videos have been produced for a number of modules.



### WP3 - Mobile for Developing ICT/Digital Literacy Skills

10 digital literacy e-courses have been created for women, and will be available on the web platform.



### WP4 - Entrepreneurship/Financial Literacy Module

This module focuses on women with the aim to develop their creativity, business skills and entrepreneurship.
