3. Background and Experience

Learnmera Oy is a private adult education provider and translation company, founded in 2011 focused mainly on corporate clients in the greater Helsinki area providing private executive business language lessons. Courses are offered in the major Nordic and European languages, but also beginner's courses in Finnish and Swedish for foreigners.

LM has considerable in-house experience in educational resource, website creation and mobile application content building.

Their website The Language Menu - tools for teachers has a member base of around 35,000 teachers worldwide. It is this technical and creative expertise that LM can bring to a project.

LM has also been the coordinator for a national e-learning project and a national m-learning project contracted by The Swedish Cultural foundation in Finland project Vårdsvenska – Swedish for health care personnel and project Swedish in Finland. Teaching material made by LM can be found (free of charge) in different languages on Scribd.com, TeachersPayTeachers, SlideShare and many other platforms on the internet.

The organisation has contracted staff as well as freelance teachers and volunteers.

As Learnmera Oy is a private adult education provider in the greater Helsinki area providing business language lessons their area of expertise is language and integration as well as ICT and they have partnered in projects in many different areas.

They also provide social media management for restaurants, bars, real estate, app creators, tour operators, and aesthetic service providers.

Youth

LM aspires to involve youth in its operations, both to help youth gain useful experience but also to capitalize on the younger generation's aptitude with social media to strengthen TA's capabilities in that area. While varying over time, between 20-30% of TA's employees have been youth under the age of 25.

Integration of foreigners in Finland

The nature of the work means that they teach many migrants and therefore help them with their needs outside the classroom and integration into the community.

LM identified a clear need for immigrants coming to Finland without Finnish language knowledge, to get support with navigating the process of becoming a bona fide resident in Finland. This led to a number of LM activities and courses to serve as a point of contact with other newcomers as well as a center for exchange of knowledge and experiences.

School

LM staff have over the years sought cooperations with various educational facilities and as result partnered with both VET educators as well as several Universities, both in Finland and internationally. LM has considerable experience in educational resource creation, STEM education, e-courses as well as tools for teachers and teacher training, especially for language teaching and online tools for material creation as well as courses on using AI tools.

Entrepreneurship



Entrepreneurship has been at the cornerstone of LM since the beginning. Not only is the founder herself a serial entrepreneur but also a person that sees and seizes opportunities as they arise. Helping others establish business is an area that LM staff have experience of and been involved in various projects on related topics. LM has also encouraged staff, having joined as junior associates, to venture on establishing their own business as professional development and continue to collaborate in such capacity.
